

Instructional Design Accessibility Workflow

1. Analyze course content and learner needs.
2. Audit course materials for accessibility barriers.
3. Apply accessibility standards to documents, media, and navigation.
4. Implement captions, alt text, and structured formatting.
5. Test course components using accessibility tools.
6. Review course using an accessibility audit rubric.
7. Iterate and refine based on feedback and testing.

This workflow demonstrates how accessibility is integrated into the instructional design process from analysis through course implementation and evaluation.
